We are delighted that you will be joining the Access to Learning Faculty. The Gateway Study Programmes are supportive courses that can help you get back into education. Our Electively Home Educated Course is for learners who are currently home educated and are looking to start attending College part time to support their learning at home.

Our teachers and mentors are experienced at supporting young people to get the most out of their time at College and prepare for their future employment. We will help you learn the skills you need to move onto the right course or apprenticeship for you. This might be helping you to improve your English and maths, learning new strategies to work with other people or developing your resilience.

Our Study Programmes include a mix of traditional teaching in smaller groups and practical learning. You will also get the opportunity to take part in Social Action Projects to help you practice the skills you will need in the workplace.

During your course you will take part in:

- English and maths learning
- Vocational – either one course or little tasters in a few different subjects
